

# King James Bible

Jeremiah 23:

**16** Thus saith the LORD of hosts, Hearken not unto the words of the prophets that prophesy unto you: they make you vain: they speak a vision of their own heart, and not out of the mouth of the LORD.

**18** For who hath stood in the counsel <sup>F107</sup> of the LORD, and hath perceived and heard his word? who hath marked his word, and heard it?

**25** I have heard what the prophets said, that prophesy lies in my name, saying, I have dreamed, I have dreamed.

**26** How long shall this be in the heart of the prophets that prophesy lies? yea, they are prophets of the deceit of their own heart;

**28** The prophet that hath a dream, <sup>F108</sup> let him tell a dream; and he that hath my word, let him speak my word faithfully. What is the chaff to the wheat? saith the LORD.

**29** Is not my word like as a fire? saith the LORD; and like a hammer that breaketh the rock in pieces?

**30** Therefore, behold, I am against the prophets, saith the LORD, that steal my words every one from his neighbour.

**31** Behold, I am against the prophets, saith the LORD, that use their tongues, and say, He saith.

**32** Behold, I am against them that prophesy false dreams, saith the LORD, and do tell them, and cause my people to err by their lies, and by their lightness; yet I sent them not, nor commanded them: therefore they shall not profit this people at all, saith the LORD.

**33** And when this people, or the prophet, or a priest, shall ask thee, saying, What is the burden of the LORD? thou shalt then say unto them, What burden? I will even forsake you, saith the LORD.

**34** And as for the prophet, and the priest, and the people, that shall say, The burden of the LORD, I will even punish <sup>F109</sup> that man and his house.

If you have never heard a message like this:

1. Be patient with me.
2. Be patient with yourself.

I am going to be talking about the King James Version of the Bible.

We are going to talk about verse 36

**36** And the burden of the LORD shall ye mention no more: for every man's word shall be his burden; for ye have perverted the words of the living God, of the LORD of hosts our God

Can God's Word be perverted?

We will be talking specifically about the NIV.

Am I being irreverent to the word of God.

Or

Are the people changing God's Word being irreverent?

Perversion; The changing of something good, true, or correct into something bad or wrong or a situation in which the change has occurred

Let's look at a couple of perversions.

KJV II Peter 1: **21** For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but **holy men of God** spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.

NIV II Peter 1: **21** For prophecy never had its origin in the will of man, **but men spoke from God** as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.

1. Can you determine the difference between these 2 versions?
2. Who would you rather have writing the Bible? Men or Holy Men

KJV Matthew 25: **31** *When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all **the holy angels** with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory:*

NIV Matthew 25: **31** "When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and **all the angels** with him, he will sit on his throne in heavenly glory.

1. Are all angels holy? No
2. Is this an accurate or false statement in the NIV's Matthew 25:31?
3. If this is considered false, can we safely presume that God didn't say it?
4. Well if we can presume that God didn't say it, then who did?

KJV Revelation 22: **6** And he said unto me, These sayings are faithful and true: and the Lord God of the **holy prophets** sent his angel to shew unto his servants the things which must shortly be done

NIV Revelation 22: **6** The angel said to me, "These words are trustworthy and true. The Lord, the God of the spirits of **the prophets,** sent his angel to show his servants the things that must soon take place.

1. Have you ever heard the term mentioned in the Bible, "false prophets"?
2. Does NIV seem to make the argument that God uses good and bad prophets?

KJV Revelation 18: **20** Rejoice over her, thou heaven, and ye **holy apostles and prophets;** for God hath avenged you on her.

NIV Revelation 18: **20** Rejoice over her, O heaven! Rejoice, saints **and apostles and prophets!** God has judged her for the way she treated you."

ASV Revelation 18: **20** Rejoice over her, thou heaven, and ye saints, **and ye apostles, and ye prophets;** for God hath judged your judgment on her.

Once again the word holy is removed.

KJV John 7: **39** (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the **Holy Ghost** was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)

NIV John 7: **39** By this he meant the Spirit, whom those who believed in him were later to receive. Up to that time **the Spirit** had not been given, since Jesus had not yet been glorified.

1. If you were trying to lead someone to Christ would you prefer they become indwelt with the Holy Spirit, or a spirit?

KJV I Corinthians 2: **13** Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

NIV I Corinthians 2: **13** This is what we speak, not in words taught us by human wisdom but in words taught by the Spirit, expressing spiritual truths in spiritual words.

1. Do you want to be taught by just any spirit when it comes to God's Word, or would you prefer to be taught by the Holy Ghost?
2. Are the wicked and evil people being taught and led by spirits?

The King James Version is the Holy Bible.

 Spirit

In 1997 the International Bible Society, and Zondervan Publishing they announced there plans to publish an updated version of the NIV.

It is called a gender accurate book.

They stated that any verse that spoke of man or mankind would be changed to people and persons.

They felt that in this day and age that they should not be specific about gender.

#### A Good Bible Translation

What, then, makes a good Bible translation? In my opinion, a good translation will follow a balanced or mediating translation philosophy. As Donald W. Burdick, Associate Editor of the NIV Study Bible and one of the translators of the NIV, put it:

“In conclusion, we have been saying that a good translation is neither too much nor too little. It is neither too slavish a reproduction of the Greek [and Hebrew], nor is it too free in its handling of the original. It is neither too modern and casual, nor is it too stilted and formal. It is not too much like the KJV, nor does it depart too far from the time-honored beauty and dignity of that seventeenth century classic. In short, the best translation is one that has avoided the extremes and has achieved instead the balance that will appeal to the most people for the longest period of time.”

## **II The NIV dares to remove the Blood of Jesus Christ**

KJB Colossians 1: **14** In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:

NIV Colossians 1: **14** in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

When you get to messing with some of these major doctrines, you are treading on dangerous territory, in my most humble but accurate opinion.

I don't care if you are Zondervan or the International Bible Society. If you are not for us, you are against us.

In this verse in Colossians what is missing? The Blood.

This perverts God's Holy Word.

### **III The NIV perverts the Deity of God**

Jesus was God coming to this earth in the flesh. God took on the form of a man. Put on a human body as He dwelt among us. He was the God-Man.

NIV I Timothy 3: **16** Beyond all question, the mystery of godliness is great: He appeared in a body, was vindicated by the Spirit, was seen by angels, was preached among the nations, was believed on in the world, was taken up in glory.

KJB I Timothy 3: **16** And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.

Manifest means to make known or show or reveal

NIV says, "He appeared in a body." Took out God and put in He.

I want you to know that everybody that has ever been born appeared in a body.  
I have not seen anybody that wasn't born in a body.

God was manifest in the flesh.

You and I were born in a body.

How subtle. How slick?  
They took out God and put in He.

He was God made known in the flesh.

KJB Philippians 2: **6** Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:

Why did Jesus not think it robbery to be equal with God? HE WAS GOD!!

He was the God-Man.

Can I explain it? No. That is why He is God and I am just a lowly human. You can't explain it either, so don't try. This is one of the great mysteries that will be unveiled when we all get home.

I believe the Bible.

The Bible says that He was made know in the flesh and He did not think it robbery to be equal with God.

Again the verse;

KJB Philippians 2: **6** Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:

NIV Philippians 2: **6** Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped,

Dictionary meaning of **grasped** - (intransitive verb to attempt to take the opportunity to do something when it arises

Now this NIV seems to make Christ question His Deity, does it not?

Well I can tell you right now that Jesus did not have any question about who He was and why He had to come.

The writers certainly seem to have questions and they leave the door open for confusion.

When Jesus shed His blood he was shedding the blood of God.

How is this possible?

Mary was a virgin.

Jesus was God come in the flesh.

The blood that flowed through the veins of Jesus, was the blood of the God of the universe.

That was pure Blood.

That was holy Blood.

That was God's Blood.

The NIV says not so.

What's the big deal you say?

Oh my, I surely hope you wouldn't ask that question.

How slick / how sly / how subtle. You may need to pray and ask God to open your eyes and help you to understand.

Are you going to take God's Word, or man's word.

A holy God

Or

Our righteousness are as filthy rags, man.

A God that can not lie

Or

[Jer 17:9](#) – Man's heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: **who can know it?**

Rom 3:4 **let God be true**, but every man a liar;

This is a big deal

When Mary is not a virgin

that is a big deal

When the Blood is retracted from the pages

that is a huge deal

When Jesus is no longer God

that is a huge deal

I mean ladies and gentlemen these are major doctrinal boo-boos.

IV John 3:16 has been perverted

More people have memorized this verse probably than any other.

Some would say that this could be the most important verse in the Bible.

The Devil dared to pervert the Great John 3:16.

KJV John 3: **16** For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

NIV John 3: **16** "For God so loved the world that he gave his **one and only Son**, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

Was Jesus God's only son?

God called Adam His son.

**Lu 3:38** - Which was the **son** of Enos, which was the **son** of Seth, which was the **son** of **Adam**, which was the **son** of **God**.

**Ro 8:14** - For as many as are led by the Spirit **of God**, they are the **sons of God**.

**Ga 4:6** - And because ye are **sons**, **God** hath sent forth the Spirit **of** his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.

**1Jo 3:1** Behold, what manner **of** love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the **sons of God**: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not.

**1Jo 3:2** Beloved, now are we the **sons of God**, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

**Joh 1:12** But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the **sons of God**, even to them that believe on his name:

Opps. They goofed again.

Let's do a little study of the doctrine of God so that you can understand it a little better.

There are some mysteries that we won't fully understand until we get to heaven but let's try to understand this if we can.

Was Jesus Created by God?                      Not according to John chapter 1.

**1** In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. **2** The same was in the beginning with God. **3** All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.

Did the life of Jesus start in Bethlehem and Mary?

No Christ is all over the Old Testament.

The most important question that anyone has to answer is, "Who is Jesus Christ?" Or, as he put it himself, "

**Mark 8:29** And he saith unto them, **But whom say ye that I am?**

In other words, although Jesus was a fully human person, he also was and is fully God.

When we speak of the deity of Christ, we cannot water it down to mean that he was supernatural, or a divine being, or most God-like. He was and is God; but he was manifest in the flesh. This is why he alone is able to redeem us.

When we read the great prophecies of Isaiah about the Messiah, we catch a glimpse of what that greatness would be:

He would have such an amazing birth (Isa. 7:14)

He would be known as Immanuel, “God with us.” And by his nature and through his works he would be known as the “Mighty God” and the “Everlasting Father” (Isa. 9:6).

A careful reading of other passages will also show that the prophecies identify the Messiah with or as the LORD.

And the New Testament fully implicates these prophecies as fulfilled in the person of Jesus. There was a birth in Bethlehem, for Messiah was to be born of the family of Judah. He would be known as Jesus.

But the Son of God did not begin at Bethlehem.

Here are a few New Testament verses you can use when speaking of the deity of Christ.

John 1 claims that he was the eternal Word, God himself, who created everything that exists, and that in time he became flesh and dwelt among us.

Philippians 2:6 makes it clear that he is God, and that he set aside the use of some of his attributes to take on the form of the human, and die for the sins of the world.

Titus 2:13 equates Jesus with God.

Revelation 5:13 and 14 portray Christ as deity. These are but a few of the New Testament passages that one would consider first in dealing with the topic.

But the creed had to focus on some of the language the Bible uses for Christ, and some of that language has confused people from time to time. How could the Son be said to be begotten if he is eternally God?

A Pauline passage, Romans 1:1-7, which shows that Jesus is the son of David and the Son of God, and that he has authority over us by virtue of his deity.

**1. The “Father-Son” Language.** At least 100 times in the Gospels Jesus called God His Father.

And then there is also the hostile witness of his enemies: they sought to kill him because he made himself equal with God (John 5:17).

From a human point of view, that is why he died: the charge was blasphemy.

There would have been no cross without Jesus’ claim to be equal with God the Father and heir of all things And everyone, believer and unbeliever alike, acknowledges that Jesus was crucified.

So the point of Jesus’ use of the “Father-Son” language was meant to teach that he was equal to the Father in nature but subordinated to the Father for the mission.

**2. The “Only Begotten Son” Language.** The second piece of evidence we must examine is the expression “only-begotten.”

It is the Greek word “*monogeneis*.” This is not simply “begotten,” for that expression can be applied to all believers, those who have been begotten or born again by the Spirit.

This is a unique expression for a unique person, the only-begotten Son of God.

The expression appears in John 1:14, 4:18, 3:16, and 3:18.

It would literally mean the “only generated one.” This is the key expression for the doctrine of “the eternal generation of the Son,” meaning, he always was the only begotten Son.

The expression does not refer to the birth of Jesus in Bethlehem, because he is the Son from eternity past.

Perhaps the language can be better understood if contrasted with synonyms.

Take the verbs “make,” “create,” and “beget.”

The verb “make” is general; one can make dinner, clothes, a house, or any other product.

The verb “create” can have the same objects, but usually elevates the act to an art:

One creates a masterpiece, or a work of art, or a symphony. While these creations bear the imprint of the creator, they do not share his nature.



But “beget” is different. You can only beget a child that has the same nature as you have--a son or a daughter.

Your son or your daughter will inherit his or her nature from you--genes, personality--all of it.

You can use “make” or “create” for producing a child; but when you use “beget” it only means you produce a child that has your nature.

Now follow this carefully. If Jesus is said to be the begotten Son of God, then Jesus has the same nature as the Father. If Jesus has the same nature as God the Father, then Jesus is divine and eternal as well.

If he is eternally God, then there was never a time he was literally begotten--which is why we know the language is figurative to describe his nature, and not his beginning.

To call Jesus “the only begotten Son” means that he is fully divine and eternal. He is God the Son.

Ain’t nobody else like Him.

Are we becoming more and more brilliant with this “age of technology”.

I believe we are becoming more and more arrogant.

V. The NIV has perverted Hell

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KJV Psalm 9: **17** The wicked shall be turned into hell, and all the nations that forget God.

The NIV hell is not mentioned at all.

In the KJV Hell occurs 31 times in the Old Testament

In the NIV Hell does not occur at all in the Old Testament.

NIV Psalm 9: **17** The wicked return to the grave, all the nations that forget God.

Wait a minute.

Don’t the righteous return to the grave too?

Unless we are raptured out of here we will all go to the grave.

This is one thing that the saved and unsaved have in common.

The NIV is removing Hell from it's pages.

If it isn't in the Bible being used in many pulpits across this nation how can so called men of God preach about Hell?

Answer; THEY CAN'T PREACH THE WHOLE COUNSEL OF GOD.

Titus 4: **2** Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. **3** For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; **4** And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables. **5** But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry.

When a preacher preaches on Hell it puts pressure on people. Makes them feel uncomfortable.

Who do you think is behind this slick, sly, scheme.

Proverbs 30: **6** Add thou not unto his words, lest he reprove thee, and thou be found a liar.

Revelation 22: **18** For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book: **19** And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.

The NIV perverts;

1. The Virgin Birth
2. The Blood of Jesus Christ.
3. The Deity of Jesus Christ.
4. John 3:16
5. Hell
6. Takes some verses completely out of the Bible.
7. Heaven
